10.00	Welcome and introductions	Children from each school introduced their representatives and school.
10.10	Introduction to KYRA Council – what's it all about? KYRA Council Values, meetings and purpose	Mr Clark from Monks Abbey Primary spoke to the group about KYRA and the role of the KYRA Council. KYRA is an alliance of schools that work together, and KYRA Council is the children's part of KYRA. The Council is about children being inspired to help schools – it is a unique collaboration of schools in the country and is becoming more recognised. Mr Clark read out an email from Mr Coy, Headteacher at Benjamin Adlard in Gainsborough, which demonstrated the kind of impact we can have on a school. Mr Clark also shared examples of other events that we have participated in, such as the Den Building challenge.
