- The National Professional Qualification for Headship (NPQH) is designed for school leaders who are, or aspire to be, a Headteacher or Head of School with responsibility for leading a school.
- The existing NPQ for Headship has been reformed to accommodate the latest evidence-based findings and reflect the new [Headteachers' Standards](#).
- The course curriculum develops skills that allow participants to be responsive to challenges they will encounter, and to identify and address persistent and common issues in school leadership.

Work in a state funded school in England that is within the top 30th percentile in relation to pupils on Pupil Premium as of the end of the previous academic year.

OR

Are a headteacher or head of school with responsibility for leading a school.

Are in the first 2 academic years of headship.

Work in a state funded school in England.
